- 4. Get your pricing and details in writing. Do not buy until you can review the deal.



5. Be willing to walk away. There will be approximately 66.7 million vehicles produced in 2023. New or used, you will find a vehicle that's right for you!

Federally insured credit unions offer a safe place for credit union members to save money. Deposits are protected by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund and insured up to at least \$250,000 per individual depositor – the same as any other federally insured financial institution. NCUA Chairman Todd Harper states, "The credit union system remains well-capitalized and on a solid footing. The agency continues to monitor credit union performance through both the examination process and offsite monitoring, and it will continue to do so into the future.
